Subject: Scheme of financial assistance for promotion and Dissemination of Tribal folk art and Culture.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the approval of President to the sanction of Rs 197000/- Rupees One lakh and ninety seven thousand (only) to Sari Nazmul Haque, Murshidabad (W.B.) towards the cost of project on 'alkalap'. The grant will be released in three installments at the rate of 30%, 50%, 80%. The second and third installments would be released after getting the Utilization Certificate statement of Accounts of previous installment duly certified by a Chartered Accountant and project report.

2. Sanction of the President is also accorded to the payment to the above institution individual a sum of Rs. 59100/- (Rupees Fifty nine thousand and one hundred (only)) being the first installment of grant of Government of India's share towards the cost of the sand project Programme.
3. The grant will be subject to the terms and conditions stipulated in the Annexure hereto.
4. The grant will be released on receipt of the Bond and Resolution duly executed by the grantee.
5. The amount of grant will be drawn by the Drawing & Disbursing Officer (Grants), Ministry of Human resource development, Department of Culture and paid to the Institution individual by means of a cheque, RTR in its favor.
6. The expenditure involved is debitable to Major Head '2205' Demand No. 49- Art and Culture Code No.04.07- Financial Assistance for Promotion tribal folk Art -1998-99 (PLAN)-04.07.31-Gtant -in- aid.
7. It is certified that pattern of assistance under the scheme mentioned above has the prior approval of the Ministry of Finance, Government of India. It is also certified that the grant is being released in conformity with the rules and principles of the scheme. the funds are available as certified by P&B vide their Dy.No. 25399-P&B dated 3.3.99 This issue with the approval of IFD vide their Dy.No. 52499-IFD dated 15.2.99.
8. The accounts of the grantee duly audited by the Chartered Accountant and audited statement of accounts with Utilization Certificate of the entire amount of the grant together with the share of Institution State Govt. U.T. be submitted to the Department of Culture after the close of financial year.
9. The Register of assets and accounts maintained by the organization individual will be opened to scrutiny by the Officers of the Department of Culture the Controller & Auditor General of India.
10. The grantee should maintain a resister in the prescribe form of all assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the Central Government grants and should not be disposed or utilized for the purpose other than those for which grant has been given without the prior approval of the Government of India.
